










GIVING BACK TO KIDS!

OZC FORUM ACCESS FROM AN ANDROID

Last issue I presented some tips for using our web site from a desktop computer. Using a smartphone or tablet is similar, although slightly more difficult, primarily because the icons are small and hard to hit with a finger tip. It helps to expand the screen by touching it with your thumb and finger and pulling or "spreading" the image out.


You can start by typing www.ontariozcar.com into your browser, Chrome in the screenshot below, then following the same procedures explained in the last issue. Once you reach the forums you may want to add the URL to your home screen. The default will be a blue square with an 0 in it. Circled in purple here.

To add the URL to your home screen, tap the three dots in the top right corner.

A window will open. Choose add to home screen. You can change the name to whatever you want. This is very convenient for other sites you visit frequently, like weather, news, or other forums














Once you are at the forum page, the procedure is the same as for a desk top computer. My advice is to login, and check the box to save your password. Your login will time out after a few hours, but by saving your password you can quickly get back on. Logging in allows you to view photos, post replies, start new threads, view who is online, and, provided you are a paid up OZC Club member, view current issues of Z Line.

As always, contact me with a pm, by phone, text or email if you need help. Next issue I will get into pm's, adding photos to your post and other nitty gritty.


